- Preliminary stages on FY18-19 NPMG (request for comments was sent out from David Hindin) and FY18-20 cooperative agreement guidance - have concerns been addressed with time allocations or do we need to discuss revising them for the CAG – is SFIREG going to do another survey
- Working on revision to PO manual- early stage, internal document. Last version dated in 2002.

SSTS Update

- Section Seven Tracking System- everyone familiar with SSTS
- In January, launched the voluntary electronic reporting for pesticide producing establishments
- Still accept paper reports but lots of efficiencies with electronic reporting option
- Provided webinars of hundreds of stakeholders on how the process is work
- Working through some bugs in the system and adding enhancements
- Understand that some states work with the Regions on potential inspection targets using SSTS data, so appreciate their patience as working through bugs of the system, but hope to have kinks out of the system and provide enhanced data to inspectors soon
- Gearing up for next reporting cycle

PIRT Updates

- We have two new members to the PIRT Steering Committee – the first is Pat Livingston from EPA Region 4 and the second is Jasmine Brown from the CSKT tribe
- Last week was the Pollinator Protection PIRT in Florida with 51 attendees and speakers.
