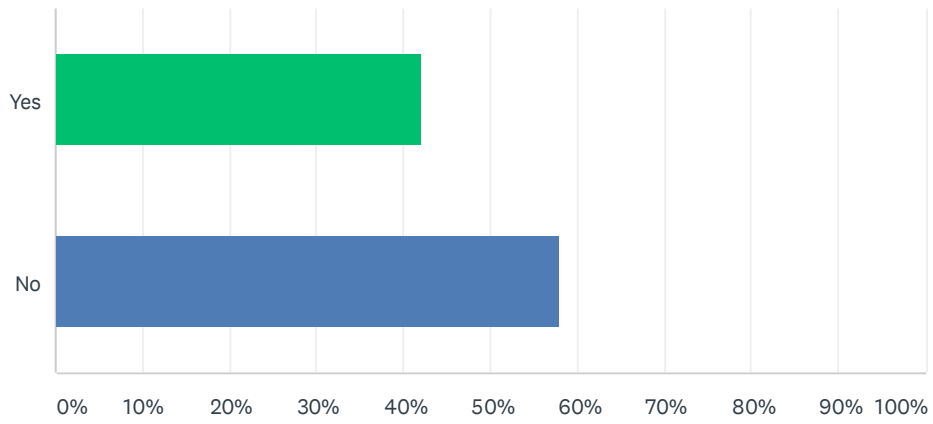


# Q1 Does your state allow for pesticides with hemp on the label to be used on marijuana?

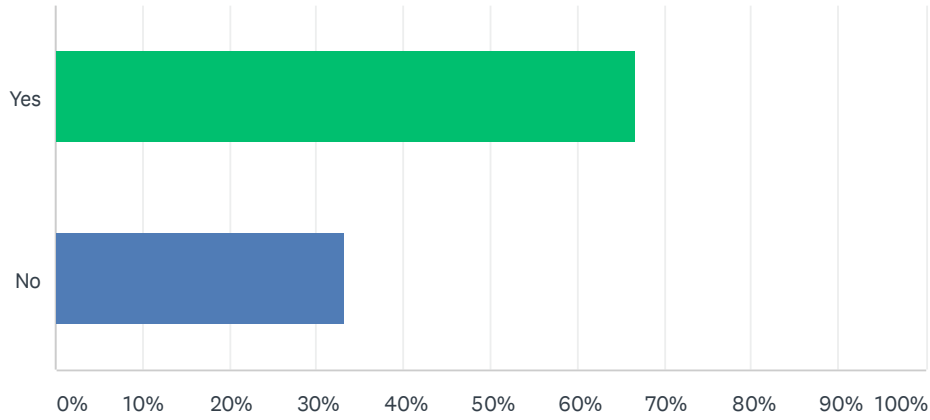

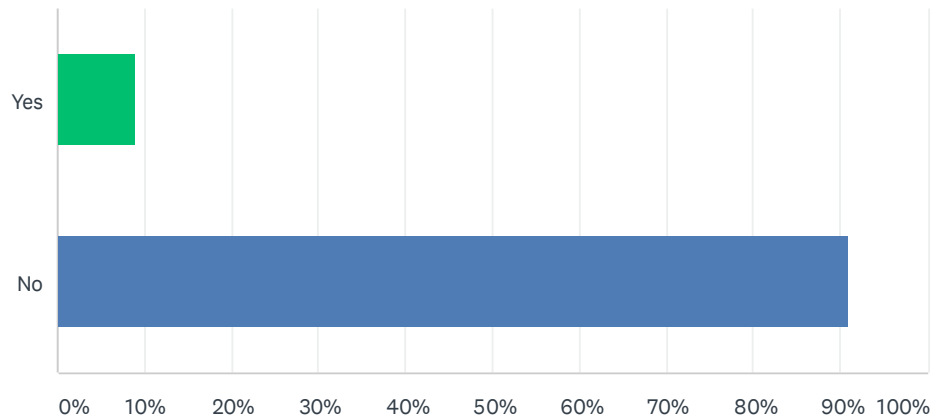

4	Any products allowed for use in the production of marijuana must meet WSDA criteria: All ingredients must be exempt from the requirements of a tolerance, and directions for use must include unspecified food crops (we consider MJ to be a food crop, and if the hemp label does not specify for "fiber only" we consider it a food crop as well.) If the label allows use on SPECIFIED food crops, including hemp, it would NOT be allowed on MJ. In order for a product to be used on marijuana, a pesticide must meet the following criteria: It is the pesticide applicator 's responsibility to identify a pesticide product that: a) contains an active ingredient that is on the list; b) the pesticide label on the container does not prohibit its use in the grow facility (i.e. indoor or greenhouse instructions) ; c) the active ingredient is registered for a food crop and; d) is registered for sale in the State of Nevada.	8/25/2020 11:01 AM
